

RESUME OF GORDON SANDERSON

FOR A POSITION ON THE ACGG BOARD OF DIRECTORS

I am asking to be re-elected to the Board of Directors of the Audi Club Golden Gate. I have served on the BOD for the ACGG for the past three years and listed below are some of the highlights of my time on the Board of Directors and some of my accomplishments during that period.

I joined the Audi club in 2001 and attended numerous Audi driving events both as a student and later as an **instructor**. Since joining the board in 2005 I have served as an **Event Master** for the Golden Gate Chapter events at Infineon, Laguna Seca, and Thunderhill Raceway. Most recently I was the event master for Audifest08 event at Infineon Raceway. In addition, I co-chaired the Audi Nationals event at Infineon in 2007. In May of this year I organized and was the event master for the first teen clinic held in Northern California. I have co-chaired Audi corral at the ALMS race at Laguna Seca for the past two years. Examples are tailgate parties at football games, summer picnic, and expanded the wine country drive to include the foothill wine country. During my term on the board the number of yearly events for members has grown from 5 to 18. I am committed to continue to improve and expand not only membership activities, but to do my part in developing on going relationships with the clubs valuable sponsors.
